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## SUMMER WEIGHT SIZE CHART <br> Note: Print This Document Do Not Place Hand on Monitor for fitting

Most people have a fair idea of their hand size from purchasing other gloves over the years. If you have an idea that you use an X-large for instance, however you know that you have a large muscular hand, then go up a half size based on that experience. If you know that an X-Large is usually a little big because you have a smaller hand structure, then go down $1 / 2$ size.

If you order a glove and it isn't just right for you, simply return it in as new condition, and we will send the corrected size. Here is a sizing chart, if it measures $47 / 8$ inches from $A$ to $B$ then the chart should get you very close.

You must still use your judgement based on your experience and knowledge of your own hands.
