
Using the LaserShooter for Gun Fit

The Red LaserShooter is a very popular accessory with gunfitters and general users of the Shotgun Combo Gauge.

Using the Red LaserShooter while gun fitting will accurately show exactly where the shot will be centered.

Simply push the LaserShooter shaft into your gun's muzzle. Touching the finger ring to the gun's trigger fires the laser.

The shot can be made in a natural swing and mount procedure or in an aiming position at the supplied target.



When the trigger is pulled and the red laser activated, both the shooter and fitter can instantly see if the gun is shooting where the shooter is looking. There will be no guessing. Stock adjustments can then be made.

The gun should be an extension of the shooter's body and when it fits correctly the swing and mount should result in the gun pointing naturally at the target.



The All-Gauge Red LaserShooter, RLS-4, along with the Shotgun Combo Gauge, are considered basic equipment for the gunsmith, stock maker and gunfitter or multi-shotgun shooting enthusiast.
